Know Your Chlorine Level Before Emptying Your Pool



Dechlorinating your swimming pool prior to emptying is more than just a good idea, it is required by city ordinance. Not taking proper measures when draining your pool can add pollutants to our stormwater, such as copper, chlorine, and even nuisances such as mosquito larvae. Chemicals that get added to pools for maintenance purposes are toxic to fish and other aquatic life.

Test the level of chlorine. If the residual is zero then it is safe to discharge to your yard in an area that will allow the water to percolate into the ground. Please be kind and avoid flooding neighbors.
