Project Limits: 1000 feet west of Wolf Ranch Parkway to 440 feet west of I-35 frontage

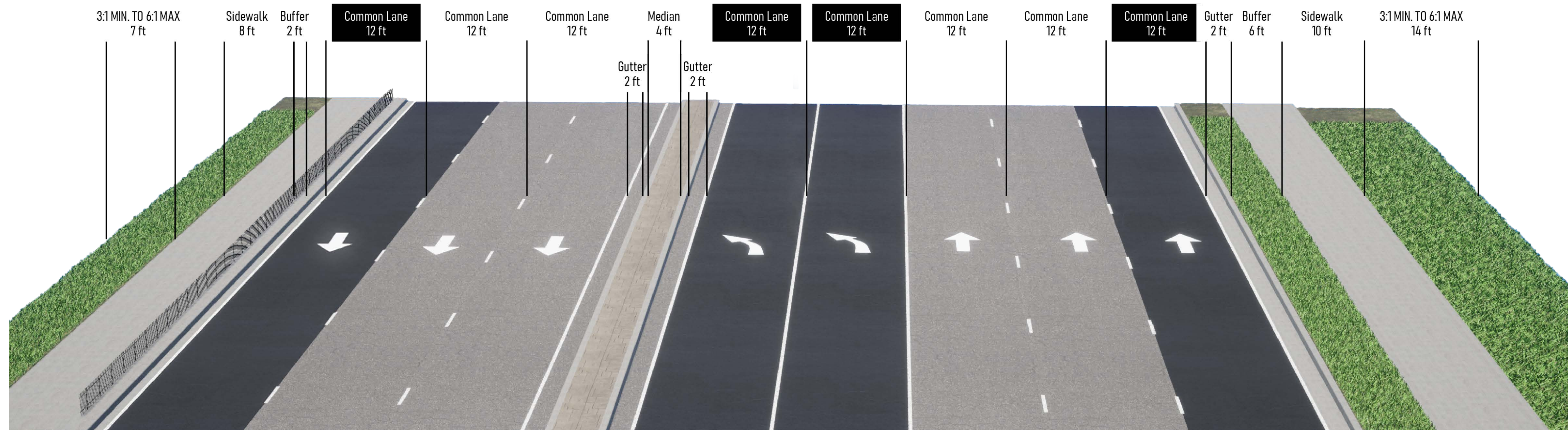
Estimated Project Cost: 9.0 million

Construction Schedule: 2024-2025



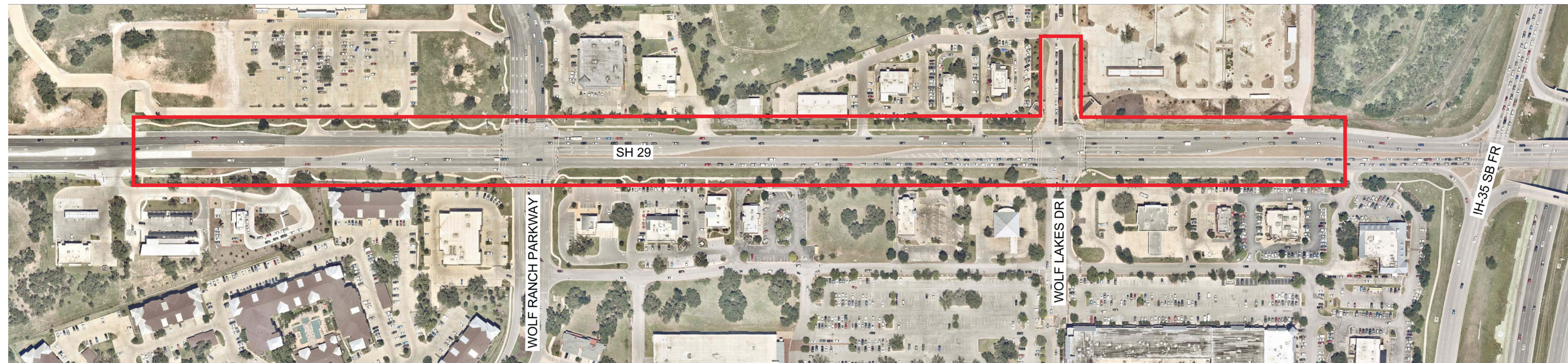
Proposed Typical Section

Project Need

The 0.61 Mile project will upgrade the existing four-lane divided roadway to a six-lane divided highway with left and right turn lane extensions as needed, storm sewer, and signal infrastructure improvements. The project also includes a shared-use path for pedestrians and bicycles on both sides of the corridor to access local businesses.

Project Need

Williamson County has experienced significant growth in recent years, and current population projections predict that this trend will continue from 34,684 annual average daily traffic (AADT) in 2021 to 48,558 AADT in 2041. The City of Georgetown is ranked as one of the top 10 fastest-growing cities by the U.S. Census Bureau*.

The SH 29 West Widening Roadway Improvement project will improve the east/west mobility in a maturing commercial corridor.
