Project Limits: 1000 feet west of Wolf Ranch Parkway to 440 feet west of I-35 frontage

Project Schedule: Design is expected to be complete late 2024, with utility relocations complete mid 2025. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of 2025

Issues To Be Addressed: Safety, mobility, shared-use path, roadway, signals and drainage improvements.

Project Description

The SH 29 West Widening project is paid for by Georgetown Transportation Enhancement Corporation funding that addresses current and future growth to maintain a high level of safety, mobility, and quality of life for residents and communities.

Project will upgrade the existing four-lane divided roadway to a six-lane divided highway with left and right turn lane extensions as needed, storm sewer, and signal infrastructure improvements.

The project also includes a shared-use path for pedestrians and bicycles on both sides of the corridor to access local businesses.

The project design began in 2023 and is expected to be completed by fall 2024, and construction is expected to be completed in 2025.

Project Need




Williamson County and the City of Georgetown have experienced significant growth in recent years, and current population projections predict that this trend will continue from 34,684 anual average daily traffic (AADT) in 2021 to 48,558 AADT in 2041. The City of Georgetown is ranked as one of the top 10 fastest-growing cities by the U.S. Census Bureau and has experienced a population growth of 67.94% in the last 10 years^{*}.

Since 2015, Georgetown has been included in the list of the top 10 fastest-growing cities and topped the list in 2016 and 2022. For the second year in a row, Georgetown is the fastest-growing city in the U.S. for cities with a population above 50,000, according to data released [May 18, 2023] by the U.S. Census Bureau. Georgetown's growth rate was 14.4 percent from July 1, 2021, through July 1, 2022, resulting in a population estimate of 86,507*.

The SH 29 West Widening Roadway Improvement project will improve the east/west mobility in a maturing commercial corridor.
