

Project Overview

The City of Georgetown, in coordination with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), is planning improvements to FM 971 to address increasing traffic volumes due to growth in this area of Georgetown. The proposed project would widen the two lanes to a four-lane divided roadway to improve traffic flow and enhance vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle travel safety.

Planned Improvements:

- Construct an additional lane in each direction
- Construct a raised median and dedicated left-turn lanes
- Relocate access to San Gabriel Park with a connection and intersection improvements at Parkview Drive
- Construct a shared-use path for pedestrians and bicycles
- Construct a closed storm drain with curbs and gutters



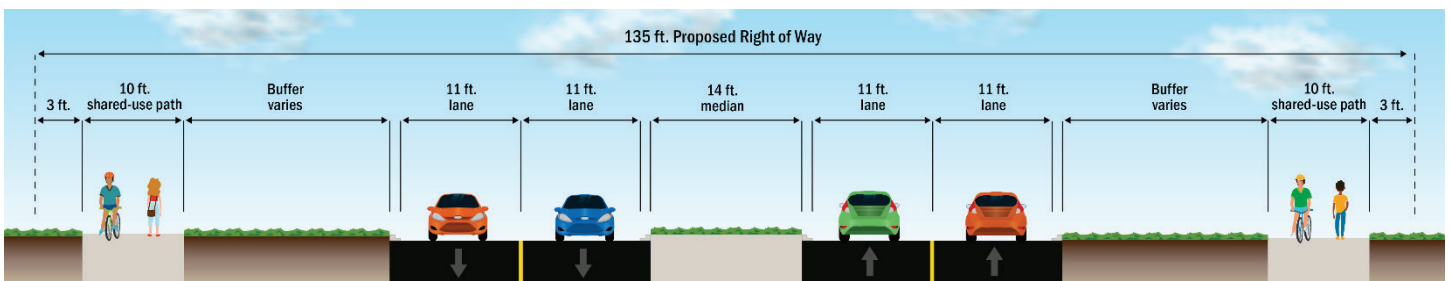
Project Funding

The City received a federal Community Funding Project Grant and funding from the 2023 Williamson County Road Bond.

Project Timeline

Preliminary design and environmental clearance are anticipated to be complete in spring 2024. The City will then develop full design and construction plans and begin coordination with property owners for acquiring the needed Right of Way. A timeline for construction has not yet been determined.
